

# **Region 2 Suicide Advisory Board Minutes**

## Time: Tuesday August 2, 2022 at 10:30 am via Zoom

### Welcome & Introductions

**988 Presentation:** Taylor Gainey shared a presentation from DCF and DMHAS; it covered the new 988 Suicide Hotline, Key components of the implementation plan, addressing the transition/operational system, Youth, and adult mobile crisis services, and future expansions. Taylor stated that she will share the list of resources and will send the presentation/training. A doodle will be sent for group participation to work on it in the next week or so... The workgroup will work on a handout for schools providing the distinction between 211 & 988, for the appropriate referral.

**988 & 211 Distinction**: Gerri stated that the recommendation for school's mobile crisis is to call 211. 988 is for more of a personal crisis/suicide hotline. The do interconnect. Geri stated that they have a new hire and are still creating/promoting new hires.

**VA Suicide Prevention Training:** Taylor stated that she is working with a VA Prevention Coordinator, Jessica to cover VA Veterans Suicide Prevention in Region 2. A Statewide panel event will be held on 8/10 @ 10 a.m. and cover Region two; they will have 6 panelists. It will be in person and a location will be decided soon. Taylor will send the link to register.

### ASIST Training – Intervention Skills Training:

Kasi stated that they received a grant that allows for a Suicide ASIST Training Program. This evidence-based training provides curriculum techniques for all levels of people who want access for interventions. Including: leadership, lay people, etc. The goal is to learn to consult with them on needs, make a safety plan and learn suicide intervention techniques that affect change. The course is a two-full day consecutive workshop. The venue had not been determined yet. They are looking at ways to cut the cost. Kara stated that the Out of the Darkness Walk will be on Sunday October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 10 am at Town Center Park in Hamden. All are welcome.

Melissa stated that they are working with State troopers next week and Task Forces on Suicide Prevention plans.

Melvin stated that Suicide Prevention week is in September, and they will be implementing a program called One Step and running activities bringing awareness to suicide risk factors.

Kara stated that she will send Taylor the flyer on a fundraiser at J Roos in North Haven.

Overdose awareness day event will be held in New Haven. APW will have a table there on the green. The flyer will be emailed.

Tipping the pain scale is on Tues. August 23<sup>rd</sup> at the North Haven movie theater. Addiction and Opioid use.

Aug. 31<sup>st</sup> is Overdose Awareness Day; educational materials will be provided. A flyer will be sent. APW will also be attending the event.

Taylor will send the 988 PowerPoint, the doodle poll for a group to work on the distinction between 988-211, the doc. will be sent to the region leads, she can provide updates on the ASIST training, and send a doodle for that also, and lastly, the flyer on J Roos event.
